

Role of Parenting Style in Adjustment of High School Children

ABSTRACT The present study was conducted in Kumarganj, Faizabad District of Eastern Uttar Pradesh. The purpose of the study was to assess the parenting style, the adjustment pattern and find the relationship between parenting style and adjustment of high school children. One hundred twenty high school children (60 girls and 60 boys) of age (15-17 years) comprised the sample of the study. Parenting scale and the adjustment inventory was administered to each high school children. Data was analyzed in terms of percentage, chi-square (χ^2) and coefficient of contingency (c). Statistical analysis revealed that there exist significant relationship between parenting style and adjustment of high school children. The children with low parenting had more unsatisfactory adjustment than children with high parenting.
