I appreciate your efforts for publishing the article 'Effects of Increase in Tuition Fees in the Tertiary Institutions of Learning' [Int J Edu Sci, 17(1-3): 140-147 (2017), DOI: 10.1080/09751122.2017.1305747]. -In reading through the abstract of this article, I observed that I omitted "at" between these two words: "study universities", it should have been "study at universities" page 140, line 6. Similarly, in page 140, line 13, I omitted "in" between these two words: "her order", it should have been "her in order". In page 140, line 7 there was a typographic error in this sentence: "the majority of students felt the effects of the increase in "at" tuition fees raised by the government", I should have deleted "at" from

this sentence. Page 140, under the corresponding author, there was a typographic error: "Department of Business Management", it should have been "Department of Public Administration".
