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Bernard–Soulier Syndrome: An Inherited Platelet Disorder

ABSTRACT In the present paper, a rare, potentially fatal, inherited disease- Bernard-Soulier syndrome-which is an autosomal recessive disorder of platelet and a deficiency disorder of GP1b-IX-V complex has been reported. This complex is an important in normal megakaryocytopoiesis, platelet turnover and maintenance of normal morphology of platelets.

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
