

Palmar Dermatoglyphic Creases among Eleven Population Groups of Himalayas

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ABSTRACT This paper reports the variation of palmar creases frequencies among the Pangwalas, Transhumant and Settled Gaddis of Himachal Pradesh, Newars of Nepal and Bhutanese of Bhutan. The results of the study are compared within and in between these groups, as well as with other reports available in the literature.
