

Time Expenditure Pattern of Gaddi Tribal Women of Himachal Pradesh

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ABSTRACT Tribal women spent a large proportion of their time in carrying out household work, animal care, agriculture and allied tasks. However, gainfully employed respondents spent significantly less time while performing all these tasks than non-employed respondents. Thus, there is a scope to improve time use patterns of non-employed respondents for effective implementation of development policies and programmes in the free time available to them.
