

Inbreeding Effects on Mean of Metrical Traits Among the Children of Aligarh in North India

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ABSTRACT The present study has brought out the conformity of the hypothesis of inbreeding depression of means for certain anthropometric character. This suggests that in breeding depression increases with increase in the level of inbreeding. In the present investigation the mean values of each of the seven measurements are compared between the subjects of both sexes (690 individuals males and 492 were females) representing different levels of inbreeding between six age groups, 6 to 11 years.
