

Erythrocyte Enzyme Variation in Brahmin and Rajput Populations of Himachal Pradesh. II. Solan District

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ABSTRACT Data are presented on phenotype and allele frequency distributions of seven polymorphic red cell enzymes in two predominant caste populations of Himachal Pradesh viz. the Brahmin and Rajput inhabiting southern district of Solan. The results of this molecular biology investigation demonstrate that apparently there was similarity in genetic constitution of the present two caste groups. Furthermore, either group was found to be homogeneous with its counterparts reported earlier from different other regions (districts) of this north-west Indian state.

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
