

Secondary Sex Ratio in a Sample of the Ladiya Population of Sagar (Madhya Pradesh)

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ABSTRACT The paper deals with the secondary sex ratio among the Ladiya, residing in Pathariya Jat village of Sagar district, Madhya Pradesh. The study reveals a preponderance of male births to female births. Birth order, mother's age and father's age all are found to be maintaining an inverse relationship with the secondary sex ratio. Though the association between father's age and secondary sex ratio ($\chi^2=17.21$) is statistically significant association between mother's age and secondary sex ratio ($\chi^2=10.1$) as well as birth order and secondary sex ratio ($\chi^2=8.92$) is statistically insignificant

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
