

Relationship of Parental Education with Parenting Patterns

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ABSTRACT The present study was undertaken to study the relationship of educational level of parents with parenting patterns used by them on their children. A sample of 300 families (300 fathers and 300 mothers) were randomly selected from Amritsar, Ludhiana, Patiala and Hoshiarpur cities of Punjab. 'Socio-Economic Status Scale' by Bhardwaj and 'Multi-Dimensional Parenting Scale' by Chauhan and Khokhar were used as quantitative measures. Results showed that parenting patterns used by parent vary with their level of education.
