

### **Ancient Science of India 2: Practical Implementation of Biotechnology for the Growth of Kuru Dynasty\***

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**ABSTRACT** The epic Mahabharata is written by Maharshi Krushna Dwaipayana (known as Veda Vyasa-Jagatguru) in Sanskrit. This world famous epic is an epitome of virtues and ethics in addition to the family history of Kuru dynasty that suffered for generations without any male personality to rule the country. Evidences are available that techniques like artificial insemination, embryonic tissue transfer and use of surrogate mothers were employed to conserve the inheritance of the dynasty. Ultimately, the generation of the Kuru dynasty got divided into two groups of cousin brothers, namely, Kaurabas (100) and Pandabas (5). The Kaurabas to acquire over the country tortured the Pandabas, which finally ended with the Mahabharata war.
