An Evaluation of Student's Awareness, Usage and Assessment of Guidance Services in Tertiary Institutions in Plateau State

ABSTRACT An evaluation of the awareness, usage and assessment of guidance services was carried out among students of tertiary institutions in Plateau State of Nigeria. A total of 300 students participated in this study, they consisted of 150 male students and 150 female students randomly selected from University of Jos, Plateau State Polytechnic, Birinkin Ladi and Federal College of Education, Pankshing. The main finding of the study indicated that there is a significant variation in the awareness levels of the students in the different tertiary institutions. It was also found out that students in University of Jos situated in the city are more aware of the guidance services and they equally use and assess guidance services more than students in the Polytechnics and colleges of education. To this end, it was concluded that students should be made aware of the guidance services in the schools and made to use them.
