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Serogenetic Characterisation of the Bhil Tribe of Rajasthan

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ABSTRACT Baseline data are presented on A1A2BO Rhesus blood groups; PGMI, EsD, AK, ADA, GLO1 and ACP1 isozymes, haptoglobin and haemoglobin variants investigated in an endogamous tribal group of Bhils from Banswara district of Rajasthan. Except for the haplotypes of Rhesus and alleles of PGM1, ACP1 and ADA systems, distribution of alleles are in genetic equilibrium.
