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A Study of Finger Dermatoglyphics Among Chenehu and Lambadi Females of Andhra Pradesh, India

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ABSTRACT Finger dermatoglyphics of 50 Chenchu females and 50 Lambadi females of Andhra Pradesh, India, are reported. Interestingly, whorls are more in Lambadis when compared to Chenchus. Lambadis show accidentals and have more ridges than Chenchus. These results have been compared with those of earlier data.
