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Study of ABO and Rh (D) Blood Groups in Kodide Reddis of Anantapur District, Andhra Pradesh

ABSTRACT: The present study reports ABO and Rh(D) blood groups among 190 unrelated subjects from Kodide Reddis of Anantapur district, Andhra Pradesh. The overall picture of ABO percentage is O (45.26%) > B (31.05%) > A (16.32%) > AB (7.37%). The frequency of Rh +ve (93.10%) is more than Rh -ve (6.84%). The present data were compared with the data available on the other sub-castes of Reddis of Andhra Pradesh to understand the affinity between them.

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
