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Fertility and Mortality Differentials among the Kabuis of Saombung, Imphal East District, Manipur

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ABSTRACT Data were collected from 100 ever married Kabui tribal women of Saombung, Imphal east district, Manipur. In this paper an attempt has been made to understand the fertility and mortality trends and also some of the factors affecting fertility and mortality. Educational status has inverse relationship with fertility and occupation also can influence fertility. The average live birth per Kabui mother is 4.01. The neonatal deaths percentage (0.25 percent) is extremely low while prenatal, infant, early and late child death percentages are 3.37 percent, 3.74 percent, 2.74 percent and 1.00 percent respectively.
