ABSTRACT The birth of Kazakhstan was great and worthy. The researchers have analyzed the historical significance of scientific works of al-Mashani in Heritage Research eastern thinkers, as well as his great contribution to the development of Farabi directed science. The scientist had read many books by Nosir Abu al-Farabi, which proved that he was a Kazakh and was born in Otrar, the largest center of the ancient culture of Kazakhstan and Central Asia, which was called Farabi. Akzhan Mashanov was rightly regarded as the first consultant to study the scientific heritage of great ancestors including al-Farabi. His findings which brought back the memories of al-Farabi were noteworthy and commendable.
